



PLANTING FOR **KOALA HABITAT** IN THE TOOWOOMBA REGION

Maintaining and enhancing Koala habitat on private land will help ensure the koala is around for many years to come. Koalas are particular about their food source and only eat a few tree species, preferring different tree varieties in different regions. When planting for koalas, it is best to offer diversity if possible, choosing trees specifically for your region. Trees grown from locally sourced seed will have the best chance of survival. Your local community nursery is a great place to start to source suitable trees.



PRIMARY TREES

- *E. tereticornis* (Forest Red Gum aka Blue Gum)
- *E. camaldulensis* (River Red Gum)
- *E. robusta* (Swamp Mahogany)
- *E. biturbinata* (Grey Gum)
- *E. punctata* (Grey Gum)

SECONDARY TREES

- *E. microcorys* (Tallowood)
- *E. molucana* (Gum-top Box)
- *E. populnea* (Poplar Box)
- *E. dunnii* (Dunn's White Gum)
